- Riders aged 15-25 years (minimum/maximum age on day of competition)
- Horses must measure a minimum of 14.1hh
- Horse Hire may be available – please contact organisers directly.
- A minimum of 3 and maximum of 7 players per team with a minimum of 3 horses/riders and maximum of 6 horses/riders at one competition
- Players may enter as single players and the Events Team will do their best to create teams from any single entered players.

VETERINARY:

A veterinary inspection will take place at least 1 hour prior to the match start time.

Vaccinations must be up to date in accordance with FEI rules; horses must have received a booster vaccination or second vaccination of the primary course within **6 months** and 21 days of the event but not within 7 days of competition.
