

## Strikes & Sanctions:

Strikes may be given to players on the following circumstances:

- Missing entry deadlines
- Late/ not fit for Trot up
- Not paid/ attended registration
- Missed timetable jobs, including refereeing, scoring and commentating
- Late/ not fit to play your match
- Breaking the code of conduct

The Referees will be checking each match that the designated people have turned up for their jobs, if you have not for whatever reason without agreeing a replacement beforehand then you will be subject to a strike.

Once you or your team accrue 3 strikes you will be subject to a Sanction:

**Sanction 1.** Your team losing the right to 1st pick-up (in either half of the game, the other team start with a p3).

**Sanction 2.** Your team losing 3 goals from your overall weekend goal count.

**Sanction 3.** Committee review.

---

**Sanction 1** = 3 strikes

3-9 Strikes and Sanction 1 will be repeated in forthcoming matches.

**Sanction 2** = 9 strikes

**Sanction 3** = 10+ strikes

---

Sanction 1 will be actioned at the following league weekend. UNLESS it is the last league weekend of the season in which case, the automatic sanction will be Sanction 2 (3-9 strikes).

Sanction 2 will be actioned from those weekends' points.

Sanction 3 will be communicated by the committee once a decision has been reached.
